## **Administrative Reports**

Due to the Eco-belt taking out so much material, we may need to increase our Garbage pickup from two times a week to three times a week.

## **Entity Reports**

City of Hayden –A new City Administrator has been hired and is coming on board December 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup>. Roger Saterfiel will no longer be with us after December, and will finally be able to retire.

Hayden Lake Sewer District (HLSD) – Finished up with improvements on Forest Ridge Lift Station, and they are continuing to track I-n-I

Kootenai County - Gaston Patterson is now the permanent airport director.

## Discussion and Decision on Honeysuckle/Ramsey Roundabout

Jon Baune, J-U-B Engineering, gave the project update on the HARSB Ramsey and Honeysuckle roundabout, see enclosed presentation. J-U-B Engineering discussed that HARSB is getting a good

value in the economy of scale since this is a City of Hayden project. HARSB has pipes, air release, and valves in the ground in the Roundabout area, and the upgrade roundabout plans were originally stamped in 2018. City of Hayden has the project funded, but the project schedule may change at this point due to not having the Idaho Transportation funding which was driving the schedule of going to bid in February 2024.

Barb Neal requested Benjamin Allen read the email submitted by Michael Schmidt (District legal counsel) and the District requested that this item be tabled, see enclosed email.

Ken Windram discussed the cost sharing on the replacement fund as 76.03% City and 22.95% District, while the O & M cost sharing for the Interceptor is 50/50.

Board discussion occurred regarding this issue and the District's next meeting is December 6<sup>th</sup>.

HARSB will set a tentative date of December 8<sup>th</sup> to discuss this topic, following the District's meeting.

## Discussion on I-90, SH-41 to US-95 Utility Information, Waiving of Utility Public Hearing

Benjamin Allen discussed the Waiving of Utility of Public Hearing, see enclosed waiver. Benjamin Allen discussed that the waiver stated that we would waive our rights to the Idaho Code Requirements if adjustment or changes to our lines are needed. Unsure why the waiver is necessary if our lines as stated don't need to be moved. Under Idaho Code they can require us to move any lines (pipes) that they need us to move.

It was moved by Barb Neal, and seconded by Roger Saterfiel, that HARSB not waive our rights to the public hearing process.

## Approval to Purchase Vehicle

So, the only company available was Ford, and the staff picked their motor preference for reliability and maintenance ease.

Ken Windram discussed the need to have assistance with the O & M Manual. We do not have a cost at this time, the cost would come out of the existing construction management funds. Tabled until the December 8<sup>th</sup> or 21<sup>st</sup> meeting.

#### Discussion and Decision-Administrator at Maximum Vacation Accrual Limit

Ken Windram discussed the need to lift his vacation accrual limit until the O & M manual is done. Board discussion occurred on this, and talked about lifting the limit until the end of January.
